Subsequently, he finished his internship at Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center and began six-year Obstetrics, Gynaecology, and Fertility fellowship at Israel's Sheba Medical Center (One of the top ten hospitals in the world). He practised as a fertility specialist at Sheba Medical Centre and Tel Aviv Medical centre, two of Israel's leading women's hospitals. He was the medical director of the principal outpatient emergency obstetrics and gynaecology center in Tel Aviv, leading a team of 30 doctors for three years before deciding to relocate to Australia.

Daniel is passionate about fertility preservation and oncofertility and is committed to improving cancer patients' fertility outcomes. He is involved in research in this field and provides specialist care in the Fertility Preservation Service at Melbourne IVF, the Royal Women's Hospital, and the Royal Children's Hospital.
